

NEW HAVEN SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING HELD MAY 18, 2006

CALL TO ORDER

Supervisor Wilbur called special meeting held May 18 to order at 4 p.m. Roll call: Councilman Perras, Councilwoman Schmidt, and supervisor Wilbur present. Councilman Parkhurst and Councilman Yablonski absent. The press was notified and a notice was posted.

NEW BUSINESS

Revaluation Progress: To date data has been collected on approximately 975 parcels. There are approximately 756 parcels to go. At this point data collection is approximately 310 parcels behind schedule. Briggs Appraisal has submitted a plan that includes increasing the number of people in the field from one to three to get the data collection back on schedule. Based on the presentation of this plan no action will be taken against Briggs Appraisal at this time. The next progress meeting is tentatively scheduled for June 8th.

Work Truck: The Highway Superintendent has specks for a work truck. The matter will be addressed at the next regular meeting.

Water District #3 Progress: Supervisor Wilbur met with Bob Guminiak of Burley - Guminiak & Associates. A draft plan of the northern portion of Water District #3 has been completed.

Salt Building Roof: The Town Attorney has been contacted concerning recouping the money paid out on the salt building roof that we did not receive. He is investigating what has been done and what we have to do to recoup the money.
