

NEW HAVEN TOWN PUBLIC HEARING HELD NOVEMBER 4, 2010

PRELIMINARY BUDGET HEARING

Call to Order: Public Hearing on the Preliminary Budget was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Acting Supervisor Wells.

Attendance: Councilwoman Prosser, Councilman Rombough, and Acting Supervisor Wells Present. Councilman Sturtz joined the meeting in progress.

Purpose of Meeting: to hear comments in favor of and opposed to adoption of the proposed New Haven Town Budget for 2011. Notice of Public Hearing was legally advertised and posted. Also present were residents Mike Prosser, Holly Bayle, and Jody Lawton and Town Clerk Debra Allen.

Comments: Holly Bayle asked why the highway superintendent was getting such a large raise. Members of the board explained that it was because a previous highway superintendent had not taken raises because he would lose more in social security than he would gain by taking the raise. This made the pay rate for the highway superintendent barely more than his employees made.

Adjournment: Having no further comments or questions, the meeting was closed at 6:24 p.m. by motion of Rombough, second by Sturtz. Unanimously carried.
